ARRIVAL TIME

We have 2 start times: 9:30 and 12:00. This is the only time you can pick up tickets and rentals.

WHERE TO MEET

The leaders will have your tickets for you in the Pennsylvania Banquet Room by the window overlooking the Teaching Hill. It is fairly safe to leave all your belongings at the tables, although neither the Ski Group nor Camelback can be held responsible for lost items. There are rental lockers available if you prefer.

LESSONS

Lessons are available for age 4+ for skiing and age 8+ for snowboarding. Lessons are at 10:15am. You must be in the lesson area 15 minutes before lessons begin. If you are late, you will miss the lesson. They will not hold up the classes for anyone! Your group leaders believe that everyone can benefit from lessons. Lessons are available for every skill level.

RENTAL EQUIPMENT

If you're unfamiliar with the equipment, don't hesitate to ask for help. If your equipment is not the right fit, it is easy to exchange it. Memorize the ID number on your skis/board before leaving them on the rack when you take a break. Each set of equipment is adjusted to fit only one pair of boots. After taking a break, make sure you

don't take someone else's equipment.

WEATHER

If weather conditions prohibit safe travel, the group, as a whole will cancel for a particular day. In this situation, please check your email before you leave. We will try to make a decision by 6:00am and immediately email all group members. Cancellations due to weather conditions always cause some inconvenience. Please be patient with us as we try to serve the group as best we can. If the group cancels a regular day, we will tack on one more Tuesday at the end of our 6 week schedule.

ABSENCES

Each member is allowed a voucher for each absence during the season. For that absence, collect a voucher from one of the leaders. You may use it on any other Monday through Friday (non holiday) during the season. On the day you use your voucher, just bring it to any ticket window. **Vouchers are transferable only if the original skier won't be able to use them.** Please contact one of the group leaders at least 24 hours in advance if you know you will be absent on a particular day.
