

PARENTAL AGREEMENT

2008/2009

Due to the number of participants in our prepaid program, Camelback has set guidelines in order to eliminate any confusion for all concerned. Both the participant and the parent/guardian must sign and return this form with payment to your group leader.

-Refunds will be issued only with a doctor's excuse. The written doctor's excuse must be given to the group leader. Be sure to include group name, parent/guardian name, participants name, home address, phone number and what was purchased through the program.

-Refunds will not be given:

-If a student is uncertain about sports team eligibility at the time of program registration and decides not to participate or is unable to ski after payment is made

-For ski/snowboard rentals because you purchase equipment or are given equipment after the program registration

-If participant never uses the rental equipment

-If a student/parent changes their mind and decides not to participate after payment is made

-If student or parent obtains a job at Camelback after payment has been made

Rentals

-We recommend that your child be sure about their rental equipment decision, skis or snowboard.

-Once the rental has been purchased, **there are no exchanges or refunds**. i.e. If your child is trying snowboarding for the first time and decides he/she does not like it, they forfeit that purchase. No credit or refund will be given for the snowboard rental.

-Absentee rental forms can only be used by the purchaser. They can not be transferred to anyone else.

-Rental forms that are lost or misplaced will have to be repurchased. (Lost forms can be used by anyone and are therefore considered valid.)

-If your child has their own snowboard, it must have metal edges and strap-in or step-in bindings. Also snowboard boots are required. Visit your local ski or snowboard shop for advice on proper equipment.

Ski/Snowboard School

-As with equipment rental, once your child has registered for ski or snowboard lessons, there is no transferring.

-Your child is entitled to five lessons. If they miss a lesson, it is made up on the group's complimentary visit.

-When parents are providing transportation, it is the parent's responsibility to have their child to Ski/Snowboard School on time. Instructors will not hold classes for late arrivals. If a skier/snowboarder misses the scheduled group lesson, the lesson is forfeited.

-All group members 18 & under taking lessons must complete a Ski School Release form prior to the first lesson. This form should be completed by a parent/guardian and returned to the group leader with payment. The release form agrees that the child may progress from advanced (Easier-Green) to intermediate (More Difficult-Blue) to expert (Most Difficult-Black) only at the discretion of the Ski/Snowboard School. A group representative/parent or guardian must be available to pick up children once the lesson is over. The Ski/Snowboard School Staff is not responsible for children once the lesson has ended.

-All lessons for children under 8 will be taught on the Teaching Hill, the Coolmoor Trail and the Sunbowl Trail. Children this age will not be taken to any other part of the mountain during a lesson. Children under 8 should not ride the upper mountain chair lifts by themselves. In order to accommodate them in the program we will keep them on the beginner chair lifts and in a more controlled area.

Absentees

-When your child misses a scheduled group trip, Camelback provides the group leader with an absentee voucher that allows your child to make up the missed trip. Your child will only receive an absentee voucher for one of the five paid trips. If they miss the complimentary visit then they forfeit that visit.

If your group visits on:

Midweek Nights absentees are valid, **Monday - Friday non-holiday 3 pm to close**
Midweek Days absentees are valid, **Monday - Friday non-holiday 9 am to close**
Weekend Nights absentees are valid, **Any non-holiday night session 3 pm to close**
Weekend Days absentees are valid, **Any open- to- close non-holiday session**

Please make note that absentee vouchers are not valid during the Martin Luther King holiday, Monday, January 19, 2009 or President's Week; Saturday, February 14, 2009- Friday, February 20, 2009. Absentee vouchers are valid only for the ski season in which they were purchased. The 2008/2009 Ski Season will end in March 2009. If your child has purchased rentals in this program, they will have been issued an absentee rental voucher. As with the ticket voucher, the rental cannot be upgraded or transferred to another person.

Once the program has begun, any questions, concerns or problems you may have must be brought to the attention of the group leader. It is the group leader's responsibility to contact Camelback on your behalf. They will be sure to address your concerns and contact the supervisor in charge.
