Welcome to the 2008-2009 Six Flags Six Hour Reading Club®! Your child's school is participating in an exciting program that encourages children in grades K through 6 to read for fun. The Six Flags Six Hour Reading Club is part of Read to Succeed®, a free educational program designed to enhance language arts curriculum. Six Flags has created this program in cooperation with Weekly Reader.

Every student who completes six hours of recreational reading by the date below set by the school (and before the **March 3, 2009** program submission deadline) will earn a free admission ticket valid at participating Six Flags theme parks. We encourage you to support your child as he or she strives to achieve this goal!

Here's what you need to know:

- Only students in grades K through 6 are eligible to participate.
- Review the Keeping Track form your child needs to use to record what and how long he/she reads.
- Your child must complete six hours of recreational reading.
- Your child can read books, magazines, comic books, or newspapers. What doesn't count is any reading your child must do for homework or a class assignment.
- Kids can read silently, aloud, or with an adult—you can read to your child, or your child can read to you.
- Initial each entry and sign the Keeping Track form to verify that the six hours of reading have been completed.
- Remind your child to return the Keeping Track form to his/her teacher on time in order to be eligible.
- Tickets will be distributed to students by the school's Reading Club Coordinator.
- The ticket is valid from June 15, 2009 to August 9, 2009.
- Lost, stolen, or damaged tickets cannot be replaced.

We hope that you and your child enjoy participating in this free program and spend time reading together.

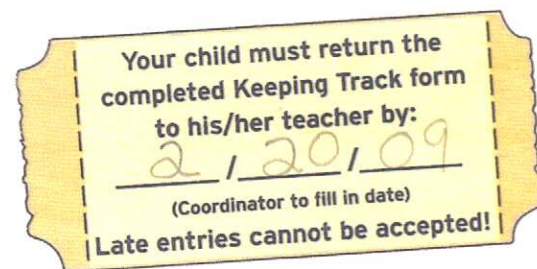
